Your eleventh feature film is part of what is almost a genre in itself: the family film. What was the origin of this project?

The origin, I don't know exactly, but what I can say is that I carried this story on me for a long time, maybe even forever and that it took me all this time and all these movies to let me tell it. But from the moment it became clear, everything went very fast. In the fall of 2017, when I had just finished The Prayer, I wrote a first twenty-page manuscript that I read to Sylvie Pialat, the producer, who immediately had the intuition that the project would arise quickly, as if she had felt both an emergency and A risk of delay. And from there, everything was linked very quickly: the writing of the script, the search for actors and financing, until the filming that began shortly after. For me, who is calmer in nature, it was a bit dizzying, but I took it as a challenge.

The feature of the film, which borrows from the theater, appeared to write quickly?

There was no intention of doing "theater", but let's say that it was naturally imposed by the subject, since there is a unity of place (the house), of time (the film is happening in less than 24 hours) and action (everything is organized around mother's birthday). The film is built in three acts and the dialogues are abundant. Theatricality also comes from the characters themselves, since they have the feeling that they are represented, that sometimes they play a role that is imposed on them, sometimes with an almost vaudeville side. And with respect to the two presentations that occur during the story (the film of the work of Romain and Emma), they function as Russian dolls, which give perspective to the story. They also offer a way out, a bit as if fiction became the last bastion against madness.

Like most of the heroes of your previous movies, Claire is a character "to the limit." But for the first time, this character is female.

Yes, it is true and, in general, I would say that it is a film in which women are at the center. Powerful, comic, tragic women. And as far as I am concerned, I would say: finally! It was time ... And I loved this job with all these actresses.

These shows also bring good humor, lightness. More generally, tragedy and comedy coexist throughout the film.

I wanted to tell a family a little crazy but also very happy, where everyone can express their imagination, their creativity. They have very hard relationships with each other, sometimes balancing terrible things, but it is their way of loving each other. I wanted it to be very lively, very "tripal," with children who don't care, drink wine, climb tables, adults who behave like children, a true freedom of tone. Everything about them is instinctive, spontaneous, the opposite of an educated or "psychoanalyzed" family.
